### Round Toe for the Rose Opal Knits DK Weight Sock Recipe for Magic Loop



The Round Toe gets its shape by decreasing stitches evenly spaced in a decreasing round. Then it is followed by a set number of plain knitted rounds. This pattern repeats with the decreasing stitches moving closer together as the toe nears completion. The Round Toe is the shortest toe by the length in The DK Weight Sock Toe Series.

#### **Abbreviations**

k - knit
st(s) - stitch(es)
rnd(s) - round(s)
k2tog - k 2 sts together

The toe decrease instructions are written by size.

Knit stockinette stitch until you are 1.5 inches away from the tip of your longest toe. Start your toe decreases for your sock size as follows:

## small (40 sts - 20 on each needle)

rnd 1 - *k3, k2tog, repeat from * to end
rnd 2 - k
rnd 3 - k
rnd 4 - k
rnd 5 - k
rnd 6 - *k2, k2tog, repeat from * to end
rnd 7 - k
rnd 8 - k
rnd 9 - k
rnd 10 - k
rnd 11 - *k1, k2tog, repeat from * to end
rnd 12 - k
rnd 13 - k
rnd 14 - k
rnd 15 - k
rnd 16 - *k2tog, repeat from * to end
```

# medium (48sts - 24 on each needle)

```
rnd 1 - *k4, k2tog, repeat from * to end
rnd 2 - k
rnd 3 - k
rnd 4 - k
rnd 5 - k
rnd 6 - *k3, k2tog, repeat from * to end
rnd 7 - k
rnd 8 - k
rnd 9 - k
rnd 10 - k
rnd 11 - *k2, k2tog, repeat from * to end
rnd 12 - k
rnd 13 - k
rnd 14 - k
rnd 15 - *k1, k2tog, repeat from * to end
rnd 16 - k
rnd 17 - k
rnd 18 - k
rnd 19 - *k2tog, repeat from * to end
```

## large (56 sts - 28 on each needle)

```
rnd 1 - *k5, k2tog, repeat from * to end
rnd 2 - k
rnd 3 - k
rnd 4 - k
rnd 5 - k
rnd 6 - *k4, k2tog, repeat from * to end
rnd 7 - k
rnd 8 - k
rnd 9 - k
rnd 10 - k
rnd 11 - *k3, k2tog, repeat from * to end
rnd 12 - k
rnd 13 - k
rnd 14 - k
rnd 15 - *k2, k2tog, repeat from * to end
rnd 16 - k
rnd 17 - k
rnd 18 - k
rnd 19 - *k1, k2tog, repeat from * to end
rnd 20 - k
rnd 21 - k
rnd 22 - k
rnd 23 -*k2tog, repeat from * to end
```

# Finishing the Toe

Cut the working yarn. Use a tapestry needle to pull the yarn tail through the remaining stitches and cinch closed by pulling the tail into the inside of the toe. Finish by weaving in the tail.
