

## Star Toe for the Rose Opal Knits DK Weight Sock Recipe for Magic Loop



# Star Toe

FOR DK WEIGHT SOCKS

Rose Opal Knits



The Star Toe is created by alternating a decreasing round with one or more plain knitting rounds until the toe is almost completed. Near the end, every round is a decreasing round. The decreasing rounds have four evenly spaced decrease stitches.

### Abbreviations

k - knit

st(s) - stitch(es)

rnd(s) - round(s)

k2tog - k 2 sts together

The toe decrease instructions are written by size.

Knit stockinette stitch until you are 2 inches away from the tip of your longest toe. Start your toe decreases for your sock size as follows:

**small (40 sts - 20 on each needle)**

rnd 1 - \*k8, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 2 - k  
rnd 3 - k  
rnd 4 - \*k7, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 5 - k  
rnd 6 - k  
rnd 7 - \*k6, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 8 - k  
rnd 9 - k  
rnd 10 - \*k5, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 11 - k  
rnd 12 - k  
rnd 13 - \*k4, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 14 - k  
rnd 15 - \*k3, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 16 - \*k2, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 17 - \*k1, k2tog, repeat from \* to end

**medium (48sts - 24 on each needle)**

rnd 1 - \*k10, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 2 - k  
rnd 3 - k  
rnd 4 - \*k9, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 5 - k  
rnd 6 - k  
rnd 7 - \*k8, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 8 - k  
rnd 9 - k  
rnd 10 - \*k7, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 11 - k  
rnd 12 - k  
rnd 13 - \*k6, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 14 - k  
rnd 15 - \*k5, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 16 - k  
rnd 17 - \*k4, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 18 - k  
rnd 19 - \*k3, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 20 - \*k2, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 21 - \*k1, k2tog, repeat from \* to end

**large (56 sts - 28 on each needle)**

rnd 1 - \*k12, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 2 - k  
rnd 3 - k  
rnd 4 - \*k11, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 5 - k  
rnd 6 - k  
rnd 7 - \*k10, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 8 - k  
rnd 9 - k  
rnd 10 - \*k9, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 11 - k  
rnd 12 - k  
rnd 13 - \*k8, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 14 - k  
rnd 15 - \*k7, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 16 - k  
rnd 17 - \*k6, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 18 - k  
rnd 19 - \*k5, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 20 - k  
rnd 21 - \*k4, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 22 - k  
rnd 23 - \*k3, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 24 - \*k2, k2tog, repeat from \* to end  
rnd 25 - \*k1, k2tog, repeat from \* to end

**Finishing the Toe**

Cut the working yarn. Use a tapestry needle to pull the yarn tail through the remaining stitches and cinch closed by pulling the tail into the inside of the toe. Finish by weaving in the tail.
